On day one we headed to Eworal bay to fish the cockle weed beds. There was a lot of baitfish in the area and we targeted 8 to 12 foot of water, first fish was our biggest fish being 1.34kg. The bream were active straight away we filled our bag by 8:20am, we made a move about 10am to around the islands were Jarrod got on to a big fish only to be taken into the weeds and that was the only fish there so we made a move back to where we started, that's when we made a couple of upgrades but we still had to get through all those leather jackets. I think Berkeley Gulp must pay them to be there! We both used 2inch Berkeley shrimps in the camo with nitro jig heads in the 1/24 and 1/32.

On day two we pretty much did the same thing but this time didn't make any moves and the fish were a lot slower than day one. Patience was the key, once everyone else moved out of Eworal bay we started catching fish, we were stuck on 4 fish with only one solid fish in the tank I started thinking about a move, luckily we didn't with another great fish coming towards the end, 1.34kg and then Jarrod making the final upgrade. Finally was very happy to get two full bags and being rewarded.
